At Salt Lake School for the Performing Arts (SLSPA) we are committed to the success and growth of all our students in both the arts and academics. In the 2023-2024 school year SLSPA will begin providing Special Education services, Math and English courses, and computer labs for students taking online courses. We commit to providing support for special education students in general education classrooms and students participating in online learning.

SLSPA will support students in the areas by:

- Hire and train 2-4 Success Coaches (paraeducators) to track student progress in online courses and towards graduation.
- Prioritize data-driven instruction and provide support to paraeducators and general education faculty to better understand Aspire+ test results.
- Provide professional development opportunities focused on teaching strategies and collaboration among special education paraeducators and general education faculty.
- Focus on students who need additional support in Math by providing tutoring after school in groups and one-on-one support.
